## **PAYMENT OPTIONS\***

## 1. INTERNATIONAL

PAYPAL is the easiest and most inexpensive method internationally. This website account address is Scriptfree@aol.com and set up to quickly receive payments. To set up the transfer, just go to PayPal.com and follow the prompts. You can use your credit card there and not need to set up any bank connection. Enter my email address of Scriptfree@aol.com, and PayPal will send both of us a receipt. You can use that for your records and for tax purposes. Feel free to email me for questions. I have no credit card option here, as that is prohibitively expensive for small businesses. EBay users prefer PayPal, as an example.

DO NOT SEND CHECKS IN FOREIGN CURRENCY. The bank here will hold it up to a month to verify your bank, and then charge me a \$50 verification fee. However, if you can go to an American bank overseas, you can send a check or money order in US dollars to me, which can be cashed and deposited here with no charge.

INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS. For a small fee, you can purchase international money orders valued at up to \$700 to 30 countries, with additional countries being added in the near future (some exceptions apply). The money orders can be cashed at the post office locations of the destination country.

WESTERN UNION. The charge at your end may not be practical for smaller amounts. If used, send it in US dollars to my San Francisco office that I can provide you. Here, they can either cash it or write me a check, with no

currency charge or other fees. Ask them for options.

BANK TRANSFER. I do not accept bank transfers due to the problems of emailing IBAN banking number, name and address, and the SWIFT code of the bank. And I pay a flat fee on this end.

CASH. For small amounts this is often done without problems but with a risk of theft and rules may be restrictive in different countries. Dollars only. Allow for currency valuation shifts and bank charges for converting it to dollars. Email me first for confirmation.

## 2. NATIONAL (USA Payment Options)

PayPal is the Internet option as above with email confirmation sent to you and I directly by Paypal. Checks sent in US currency is an alternate payment method, but may take a few days longer. Your cancelled check is your receipt. Send checks to my office address which I will provide by email.
